Instructions for the submission of Conference papers and Invited journal papers

1. Conference papers:

The Main Author of each accepted Abstract is expected to submit a **Conference paper** to the Symposium O organisers. A Word template for the preparation of the Conference paper is available on the Symposium's website, together with an Author Guideline document and a Copyright form. The minimum length of the camera-ready conference paper is 3 pages, the maximum length is 10 pages. All conference papers will undergo a peer review process.

The successful conference papers will be published **free of charge** on **Energy Procedia**, Elsevier's online conference proceedings platform:
http://www.elsevier.com/wps/find/journaldescription.cws_home/718157/description#description.
Energy Procedia is an open-access online platform indexed by important databases such as ISI Web of Science. Papers on Energy Procedia are freely available to anybody. All papers published in Energy Procedia feature individual DOI numbers and are thus fully citable.
